Capacity Building Workshops

All anganwadi workers of Surat city were assessed for their knowledge, attitude, practices and problems with respect to ICDS and service delivery. A series of training sessions were organized at community centers and training was imparted with an objective to strengthen their knowledge and service delivery under ICDS.





A PPP model was designed and 10 AWCs were adopted by the private partners (Rotary Dist. 3060). Under this partnership as proposed, the AWCs were strengthened with respect to their infrastructure and various goodies like, educational games, uniforms, bags, utensils for induction stove, etc. were distributed by the volunteer members.







Various festivals and birthdays were celebrated at the AWCs other than the four Tuesdays as per the stated guidelines of ICDs including Mamta Diwas, Mangal Divas, Annaprashan Diwas &Kishori Diwas. These extra days were celebrated with an objective to increase community participation and regularize the attendance of children beneficiaries along with active participation of each mother enrolled.
