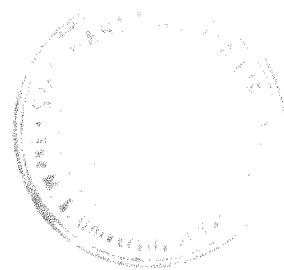


ACKNOWLEDGEMENT
