LIMITATIONS OF THE STUDY

- 1. Biochemical assessment of majority of the children could not be carried out in village setting which may have given a clear picture of micronutrient deficiency and utilization of food.
- 2. 100% participation of all the mother child pairs in each and every intervention program could not be achieved as they were not available in the village always due to various issues.
- 3. Major agricultural intervention including bio-fortification or other technological invention to improve food security could not be performed.
- 4. Food affordability could not be improved to a large extent.
