Project*: Training and Sensitization Module for AHTU Functionaries.

Proposed Organising Institutions:

Police Training Schools / Police Academy / National Institution of Criminology and Forensic Science (NICFS).

Awareness / Sensitization Programme:

- i. Basic Course for new/fresh inductees of AHTU.
- ii. Advance Course for refreshers – ideally in a vertical interaction mode.

Duration: Two to Five Days.

Batch Strength: Maximum 30 Participants, both Men and Women.

Cost: Minimum Rs. 5 Lakhs – to include reading material, transportation cost for field visits.
