CHAPTER-III

RESEARCH SETTING

In the previous chapters the researcher has tried to build up the introduction and review of related literature. The present chapter tries to describe the details of the population and the sample selected by the researcher for the study. The information of the Universities and Colleges were collected from different sources such as websites of the colleges and University, College Programme officers, Programme Coordinators of University, Annual Reports etc.

3.1. NSS VOLUNTEERS

In total the data was collected from 35 colleges affiliated to 7 different universities. 350 respondents were selected out of 6135 NSS volunteers enrolled under 58 NSS units offered by 35 colleges.

3.2. PROGRAMME OFFICERS

From each university 5 programme officers were selected as respondents.

3.3. INFORMATION OF THE UNIVERSITIES

3.3.1. Gujarat University, Ahmedabad

From Gujarat University 50 NSS volunteers were selected. The details are given below.

NSS Special camps are organized in Rural areas.
