

APPENDIX - FTOOL - 6OTHER EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES SURVEY SCHEDULE:
(English version of the original Kannada language)

The items listed in this section are related to

A. The Block Development Departments and Voluntary Organisations educational activities that have been conducted in the village so far with their objectives and the different activities that were carried out under each programme with their resultant impact on rural life if any, and B. The activities of the Village Level Worker (VLW), Basic Health Worker (BHW) and Auxiliary Nurse-midwife (ANM), along with their ideas, views and opinions on various community development educational activities and their problems in every day rural life.

The data for the section 'A' will be collected through Block Development Office records, voluntary organizations office records, panchayat office records and also through informal talks and discussions with the village adults and the concerned officials. The data, however, for the last item under part 'A' will be collected exclusively through informal talks and discussions with the village adults. The data with regard to section 'B' will be collected through informal talks and discussions with the concerned VLW, BHW and ANM.

A. On the community development educational activities:

1. What community development educational activities (agricultural extension, nutrition education, health education, population education, part-time education, adult education) have been held in the village Kadehude so far?
2. What were the objectives of each programme?
3. What activities were done under each programme?
4. What have been the resultant impact of each programme on the rural life?
5. What do you (to villagers only) feel about the various educational programmes and the activities of the VLW, BHW and ANM? What do you expect out of the various educational programmes and these officials? How should the educational programmes be organised according to you?

B. About VLW, BHW and ANM:

1. Where are you staying now? Since how long have you been working in this village?
2. What are your qualifications, and experiences in the rural life?
3. What are your duties and obligations? Have you been able to do your duties satisfactorily? Yes/No. If no, why? And what are the problems that you generally face in the rural life?
4. How do you feel about the various community development educational activities? What do you expect out

of these programmes? What should be the nature
of these programmes? And how should they be
organised according to you?
