## STUDENT REACTION TO THE THREE FORMS OF PLM IN TERMS

## OF RANKS

Below are given certain questions regarding the three forms of PLM namely (i) Linear (Unit I to IV), (ii) Deviated Linear (Units V to VII) and (iii) Branching (Units VIII and IX) through which you have been learning grammar. Please answer each of the questions by ranking 1, 2 and 3. Before doing so, examine the point in each question and rank it according to the extent each form has helped you in learning. Give rank I to the method which has been most effective, rank 2 to the method which is next in the order of this effectiveness and rank 3 to the remaining method.

The following example shows how ranks are to be given to all the three methods or ways of presentation of grammar:

	Linear (Units) I to IV	Deviated Linear (Units) V to VII	Branching (Units) VIII & IX

In the above example item (a) namely 'which method helped you to understand the concepts discussed?', the Linear method has the third rank in its effectiveness in understanding the concepts under discussion while the deviated linear and branching methods have the first and second ranks respectively. Similarly in the case of item (b) namely 'which method has helped you to understand the various principles?' Linear has the second rank while Deviated linear and Branching forms have 3rd and Ist ranks respectively. Now start responding the items by ranking the methods as shown in the above example according to your choice.
