## About the study :

Constant endeavours are being made by educationists to improve our educational system, by introducing many new ideas, new programmes, new methods and techniques which are called "Educational Innovations". To orient teachers towards new ideas and techniques various inservice courses, seminars, teacher being training programmes are/organised. 


