APPENDICES

Instructions for reading the appendices:

- 1. There are nine appendices in all.
- 2. Each appendix furnishes information about illustrations of verbcompounds included under data-collection.
- 3. Under each category, we have mentioned the serial number, and the name of the illustration of the verbcompound sources mentioning the Book and the Number indicating a page or pages.
- 4. In the case of every illustration, the <u>Roman Figure</u> indicates the book and the <u>International Number</u> the page number.
- 5. Sources have been mentioned on pages 49, 50 and 51 (Chapter I).
- 6. At the end of each illustration of the verbcompound, the figure shows the number of times the illustration occurs in the source - material.
