Instructions for reading the appendices:

1. There are nine appendices in all.
2. Each appendix furnishes information about illustrations of verbcompounds included under data-collection.
3. Under each category, we have mentioned the serial number, the name of the illustration of the verbcompound ^{and} /sources mentioning the Book and the Number indicating a page or pages.
4. In the case of every illustration, the Roman Figure indicates the book and the International Number the page number.
5. Sources have been mentioned on pages 49, 50 and 51 (Chapter I).
6. At the end of each illustration of the verbcompound, the figure shows the number of times the illustration occurs in the source - material.
