INSTRUCTIONS USED FOR THE SECOND TESTING SESSION

(A) Instructions for versions 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, and 8.

This is the second session in the experiment we started two weeks ago on the teaching of Russian language. You are going to see a different kind of film tonight which will contain a new series of Russian words. As I told you last time, this is an extremely important experiment which we are conducting for the Department of Defense. We were very pleased, in general, with the scores you made in the last session. Your scores will be made available to you through your instructors at the end of the experiment.

Does every one have a special pencil and an answer pad?

Please <u>print</u> your name - last name first, then your first name and middle initial. Do this on the <u>pink</u> page.

Now write down your age - last time some groups did not include this information.

Now turn the page to the white page.

Now we are ready for the second section. You should be on a pink page now. This evening there will be no break between repetitions. We shall go right through, till all the repetitions are complete, so that we shall be able to finish this session by 9 o'clock.

(Now give six continuous repetitions of the second section. After this give the reverse test. Lastly, remind the students of the third and the last session which is <u>exactly</u> a week after the second session, same time and same place, for all students in that class.)
