Summary of Population Education in India*

Rajasthan

The syllabi in Hindi, Social Studies and Geography aim at introducing population education mainly at middle school level. However, the textbooks of various classes in other subjects also contain some topics. The following table summarises the various topics included at different classes under each subject:

Some ideas of population education have figured incidentally in the syllabi of secondary teacher training institutions. One of its universities has recently included population education as optional paper in B.Ed. course.
