<i>Anganwadi:</i>	Children's Playhouse
<i>Ashram:</i>	An abode where people of different communities live together
<i>Ashramshala:</i>	School with boarding facilities
<i>Atmashuddhi:</i>	Sanctifying the soul
<i>Balvadi:</i>	Kindergarten
<i>Bhagat:</i>	A religiously pious person, generally tribal, who abstains from consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian food
<i>Bhag-batai:</i>	The cultivation of land on share system
<i>Chotras:</i>	The base made below a tree
<i>Chowkies:</i>	The vigilance check post situated in a village
<i>Graamdan:</i>	Donated village
<i>Gram Sudhara Smiti:</i>	Village Welfare Committees
<i>Gramnirman:</i>	Village reconstruction
<i>Gram-Sevak:</i>	Village Servant
<i>Gram-Udyog:</i>	Village Industries
<i>Gujarat Prantik Samiti:</i>	Gujarat Provincial Committee
<i>Halipratha:</i>	System of bonded agricultural labour
<i>Halpatis:</i>	Bonded labourers
<i>Hartals:</i>	Strike
<i>Inamdari:</i>	Land tenure by which officials were rewarded for their services to the state
<i>Kaliparaj:</i>	Colored People
<i>Khadi:</i>	A thick cotton fabric
<i>Khedut Parishad:</i>	Cultivators' Council

<i>Mahal:</i>	Administrative unit below taluka for revenue collection
<i>Mandalis:</i>	A cooperative society of people
<i>Mota:</i>	An elderly person
<i>Nai-Talim:</i>	A new system of education
<i>Panch:</i>	<i>Chiefs of the village council</i>
<i>Patidars:</i>	A 'superior' peasant community of central Gujarat
<i>Pinjanias:</i>	Anklets
<i>Prant:</i>	State
<i>Prasad:</i>	Sanctified food devoted to God
<i>Ranimahals:</i>	Forest-divisions
<i>Sahkari:</i>	Cooperative
<i>Samiti:</i>	Committee
<i>Sevikas:</i>	Female servant
<i>Shibirs:</i>	Training camps
<i>Snatak:</i>	A Graduate
<i>Takavi:</i>	Loan
<i>Talati:</i>	Revenue accountant and collector of a village
<i>Taluka:</i>	<i>The sub-division of district</i>
<i>Ujliparaj:</i>	White-skinned people
<i>Uttar Buniyadi Vidyalaya:</i>	<i>Post-Basic School</i>
<i>Vanijya Visharad:</i>	Commerce Graduate
