The present study attempts to specify the significant contribution of Sarva-siddhānta-sangraha on the light of *Kevalādvaita* of Ādi Śankarācārya in the field of Vedānta. Besides its philosophical aspect, it deals with the highly philosophical value. Hence the effort is made to evaluate Sarva-siddhānta-sangraha critically after comparison with Sarva-darśana-sangraha.

The study is comparative, comprehensive and critical, hence it tends to contribute towards the general enhancement of knowledge.
