BEWARA OR PARTITION REGISTER, EXHIBITING THE SHARES IN PARKHET VILLAGE, BROACH TALUKA, (C.1802)

Parkhet contained 39 anas or shares of 80 bighas each including grass land. There were nine big bhagdars in the village. Wasan Vallabh one of the bhagdars of Parkhet had five anna share containing 400 bighas of land thus distributed.
