TRANSLATION OF A COPY OF GRANT OF 100 BIGHAS OF LAND TO OMERJEE
OUT OF BROACH FARGANA

Be it known to the Muttisuddees both new & hereafter, of the affairs of the Pergunnah of Broach subject to the Shadow of God - that in this juncture it being evident - That Omerjee the son of Natha Wuhaajee the muccadum of the village of Tuckariah subject to the aforesaid Pergunnah - has ever performed the duties of Loyalty in the service of the sirkar and not possessing an Income suitable to his expences. Therefore our observation being directed upon his fidelity and past services the extent of one hundred Beeghas, is bestowed upon the aforesaid Person and his Descendants, from the villages (mentioned in the margin) - It is required that having measured and marked out the lands aforesaid from a good spot - not included in the Revenue - but fit for cultivation. (A list of royal Titles is here inserted) They should deliver them into the aforesaid Possession - That its produce Season by season & Year by year - being appropriated to his own use he may be assiduously employed according to the duties of Loyalty in prayers for our increasing & perpetual Propserity.
