TRANSLATION OF A COPY OF A FARWANA UNDER THE SEAL OF VAZIR-UL-  
MALMULUK-UL-MULK ASAFJAH BAHADUR

Seal

Let it be known to the Muttisuddies of the affairs of the Pergunnah of Broach of the Government of Broach, both new and hereafter. Subject to the Soubah of Ahmedabad, that the village of Munglesur within and without belonging to the aforesaid Pergunnah being by imperial Beneficence conferred upon Bhaeedass the Cunongoe of the aforesaid Pergunnah and his Discendents. It is required that they put the above mentioned village into the aforesaid Possession - and by no means make any change or alteration in this purport and not on any account make the least demand or Extortion - that he having appropriated the collections of it to his own use and benefit may be employed in prayers for increase of our eternal prosperity -

Written on the 1st of the month Rubbee ul awul in the 6th year of the reign.

TRANSLATE OF THE COPY OF SANAD BY DAMAJIRAO GAIKWAD SHAMSHIR  
BARADOR TO THE MAJMODAR AT BROACH, BHIDAS VIRINDAVANDAS AND  
BHUKANDAS BHIDAS

That the village of Mungleshwar in this Purgunnah, is given to your enam by Government, it therefore remains but for you, while sensible of this Gift, to avail yourself of the produce of the village and acting strict duty to your Government.

This the 9th day of the month of Ashwun vud and of the year 1812.
