A note on Kharoda.

श्रीनागर्मातिसमस्तंगोत्रामुख्योऽस्ति थः शाखरावरावरकः श्रीनागर्मातिसमस्तंगोत्रामुख्योऽस्ति थः शाखरावरावरकः

Ksāravata is a sanskrit name for Kharavada a place near Junagadha. The main families of nagara brahmins are five: Vadanagarā, Visānagarā, Citrodā, Sāthodarā and Dungaraparā. Now a days, Vadanagarā nāgaras are divided into two groups:—Nāgara brahmins and Nāgaragrhasthas; each of them claims superiority over the other. Nāgarabrāhmins claim their superiority on the ground tat they are custodians of culture by following the path of vedic ritual. While Nāgaragrhasthas who got prominent services and hence higher positions in states and occupied better civil status condemn the brahmins on their being priests.

Most of the Vadanagara nagara brahmins have been found sanskrit scholars and they have contributed a lot to sanskrit literature.

The details regarding gotra etc. of kharoda brahmins are as follows:

- (1) Gotra Bilvāpasa (Baijavāpa) (5) Pravara Atreya (Atri) Gavisthira,

 - and Purvatithi and Purvatithi (6) Ganesa Khokho.
- (4) Veda Rgveda. (7) Family deity -Siddhesvari
 - (8) Siva Acalagaccha.
