PECULIAR WORDS AND PHRASES IN THE  
 MARKANDEYA-PURĀṆA WITH THEIR MEANING  
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In this Appendix some peculiar words and phrases used in the MKP are given with their meanings.

Anātmikṛta(47.49)	=	What is without essence.
Ātmajñani (19.102)	=	One who is known by his own deeds (Ātmā svakarmanā jñāyate asau).
Bhārata (1.2 etc.)	=	The Mahābhārata.
Bheṣaja	=	(1) Expiation (1.15; 4.33). (2) Panacea (33.23).
Hārdḍī (74.24 etc.)	=	Affectionate (Hārdam asti asya).
Madhya (19.102 etc.)	=	Madhyam.

Māthura (4.56)	=	Lord Kṛṣṇa.
Nirvāṇa	=	(1) Extinguished (cf. nirvāṇāravarcaśam, 2.24). (2) Happiness (cf. param nirvāṇam āptavan). (3) Final Emancipation (37.35 etc.).
Prāleyādri (1.45 etc.)	=	The Himavat mountain.
Puruṣakāra (2.63)	=	A Manly act.
Pradhāna (42.32)	=	Chief.
Sastrapūtā (1.53)	=	Purified by weapons (Sastrena pūtā).
Uttariya (36.13-14)	=	Uttama, i.e. long; a type of three-fold Yoga.
