General Instructions

- 2. In the beginning of each section, instructions for giving responses are given.
- 3. All questions given in this booklet concern you and the answers to these questions will be different in case of each individual. Therefore there are no right or wrong answers in this test.
- 4. If you give your honest answers to each question in all the sections, it will help you understand yourself better. Your honest answers to the questions will be helpful in understanding you as well as others like you.
- 5. All your answers will be kept strictly confidential. Please, therefore, respond to them freely.
- 6. Record your answers to the questions given in this on the answer-sheet provided to you. Do not write anything in this booklet.
- 7. Read carefully all the instructions given at the beginning of each section and then start answering them. When you complete one section page, turn to the next page. Complete one section before you start responding to the other section. There is no time limit set for you for recording your responses. But quickness in responding will be highly appreciated.
- 8. Do not start until you are told to do so.

SECTION I

Instructions

Questions asked in this section are pertaining to your social life. Give your responses on the answer-sheet provided for Section I.

Read each question carefully. Then decide for yourself whether your reply is positive or negative and record it under the columns 'Yes' or 'No'. If you cannot decide whether your response is positive or negative put cross (X) under the middle column which makes uncertainty of responses. This column is represented by a question mark (?). But as far as possible use this response seldomly. Do not waste more time for one question. Record quickly your responses on the answer-sheet provided to you for different sections.

Take the answer-sheet now and start recording your responses on it. For question No. 1, an example of the response is provided in the beginning of your answer-sheet. Follow similar style of recording your responses and answer all the questions.
