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Instructions

The valuation is to be done as under :

If you have adopted the characteristic (a) extensively, put 5; (b) to a great extent but not extensively, put 4; (c) moderately, put 3; (d) slightly, put 2; (e) not at all, put 1.

The values as above are to be indicated in the appropriate columns provided for the persons. e.g.
