


Figure 1 : Showing all the Perceptual Tests Materials

Subject is comparing the variable triangle with the standard triangle




Figure 4 : Reversible Figures Test

Subject has to report the fluctuations on reversible figures assuming three different types of attitudes viz. Neutral, Positive and Negative.




Figure 5 : Memory Drum
