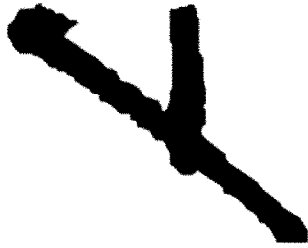

1. The first step is to identify the main topic of the document. This is usually found in the title or the first paragraph.

3. Once you have identified the main points, you should look for evidence or examples that support them. This is often found in the same paragraphs as the main points.

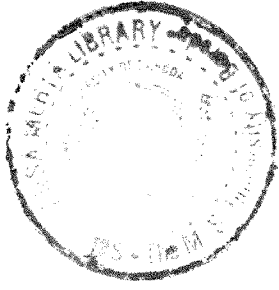
4. Finally, you should look for a conclusion or a summary of the document. This is often found in the last paragraph or in a separate section.

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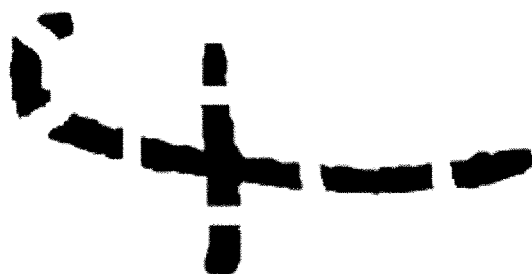
