






























Fig. A. 39, Section facing south, sub-squares B-6,



SECTION FACING SOUTH

































































14 to 24, Micaceous ware.



38 to 42, Pear shaped pots.



Fig. D, 3, 43 to 54, Red slipped ware.



Fig. D. 4, 55 to 72 Plain Black ware.



Fig. D. 5, 73 to 89, Plain Red ware.



113 to 119, Painted ware.**



Fig. D. 7, 120 to 128, Coarse Red ware.



























